The GHG Assessments were based on the WBCSD/WRI GHG Protocol, which are also compliant with the Carbon Disclosure Project and The CarbonNeutral Protocol in order to develop customised mitigatory measures to reduce their environmental impact. The assessments were also in accordance with the ISO 14064-1 Standard.

Traffi Safe financed a renewable energy carbon credit project to offset its quantified emissions to become a carbon neutral company.
